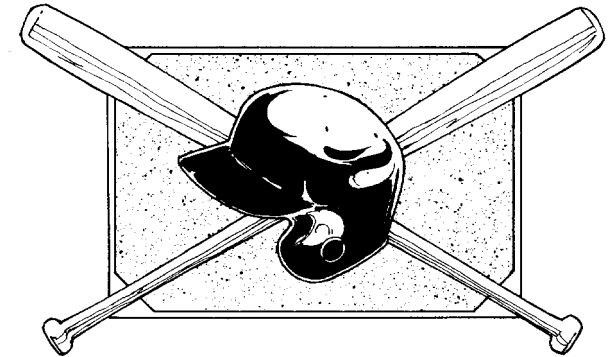

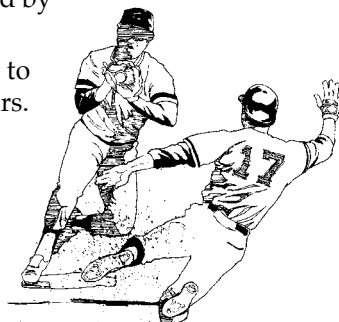

- The league will follow all OHSAA By Laws.
- League will be made up of teams with 12-15 players per squad.
- Teams will be selected at random then adjusted with consideration to ages, schools and positions.
- All players will receive a t-shirt.
- Awards will be given for :
 - Top Batting Averages (30)
 - Most Home Runs
 - Most RBI's
 - Batting Champ 13-14 Yr. Old
 - Most Game Winning RBI's
 - Batting Champ 15-16 Yr. Old
 - Most Extra Base Hits
 - Batting Champ 17-18 Yr. Old
 - Most Doubles
 - Top Slugging %
 - Most Total Hits
 - Most Triples
- Helmets, must slide rule etc. are in effect for safety.
- A pitching machine will replace a "live" pitcher and catchers will be stationed behind a "port-o-sock." Therefore walks are at a minimum. *This is a Batting League.*
- Lineups will include 8 defensive players and 1 D.H. Players rotate to new defensive position each inning.
- Players are expected to start at least 2 times a week and play 1 entire 9 inning game at least 1 time a week.
- Team captains are elected and work with league officials to develop daily lineups.
- Umpiring, score keeping and record keeping will be handled by adult staff.
- Age limit 13 years to High School seniors.

The Frosty Brown Fall Pitching League

- 3 games (7 innings) per week.
- Games will be played on weekends using 2 diamonds in Duke Park.
- No coaches; each team will select 2 captains.
- Pitchers may only pitch 5 innings or 100 pitches – whichever comes first.
 - ♦ Pitchers may not exceed 50 pitches in 1 inning.
- Umpires will be from West Central Umpires Association.
 - ♦ Most will be 1st year trainees.
- All OHSAA rules will be met; “no coaches” constitutes “open gym” situation.
- Run rule: 10 runs after 5.

Note: Teams will have minimum of 15 players per roster to avoid forfeits.
